Derek informed the board that we plan to lift weight restrictions on Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, along with the other surrounding road commissions.

Derek updated the board on the urban fund project scheduled for 2026 of Lake Dr. from Connie to the east. Derek reported on the cost share discussions he had with Todd Blake, City of Fremont Manager.

Derek reported that he and Mike attended a virtual GI meeting on Thursday with MDOT for the 2026 fed aid chip seal project. The project should be on track for a June or July bid letting.

Derek informed the board that he has a meeting today at 1 p.m. with Consumers Energy to finalize the realignment of Beech Ave. north of 16th St. project.

Derek reported on the lowering of the load limits on the bridge over the White River on 3 Mile Rd. east of M-37. MDOT randomly inspected five bridges and lowered the limits to 3 tons at this specific location. Derek informed the board that he has heard some concerns about the new limit.

Derek informed the board that we plan to end second shift on Friday, March 26<sup>th</sup>.

Derek reported on the package of information he received from the Rural Road Alliance. Commissioner Harmon received it as well.

**Public Comment:** Stu Sanders congratulated Commissioner Gonyon on his retirement and thanked the board for all that we do, especially in northern Lincoln township.

**Commissioner discussion items:**

Commissioner Fetterley thanked Commissioner Gonyon for his years of service.

Commissioner Harmon thanked Commissioner Gonyon for being a great mentor and mentioned his history and knowledge will be missed. Commissioner Harmon reported that he attended the last County Commission meeting and gave them a brief update. Commissioner Harmon mentioned that he has been meeting with Asa regularly as the Parks are getting ready to open for the season.

Commissioner Gonyon stated that he has enjoyed his time serving the public and accomplishing the things that we do with the little resources and funding that we receive.

With no objections, Chairman Gonyon adjourned the meeting at 8:50 a.m.
