The Board of County Road Commissioners of Newaygo County will receive sealed bids at their office at 935 East One Mile Road, White Cloud, MI 49349, until 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, September 8, 2021, for the following:

All proposals must be submitted on Road Commission furnished bid forms. Said forms must be in sealed envelopes, plainly marked as to item bid and shall bear the name of the bidder.

The Newaygo County Road Commission hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business enterprise will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of sex, race, color or national origin in consideration for an award.

The Board reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularities in the bids and to make award in any manner they deem to be in the best interest of Newaygo County.

Specifications for PRE-WETTING MATERIAL

It is the intent of the Newaygo County Road Commission to purchase all or part of its 2021-2022 requirements of Pre-Wetting Material – from selected source/sources.

A. Quantities:

Quantities will be ordered, “as needed” and quantities may increase or decrease.

B. Delivered:

1. Pre-Wetting Material shall be shipped in 5,000 to 10,000-gallon truck loads, delivered to designated locations and pumped in Newaygo County Road Commission storage tanks at the following addresses:
 - a. White Cloud facility
935 East One Mile Road
White Cloud, MI 49349
 - b. Newaygo facility
8527 S. Mundy Ave.
Newaygo, MI 49337
2. Deliveries must be made within twenty-four hours of receipt of order Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m., unless prior notice and arrangements have been made, at all locations.

C. Price:

1. The unit of measurement shall be per gallon, FOB delivered, and pumped into our storage tanks for each delivery.
2. Firm price through December 2022 must be bid.
3. Invoice for material must be submitted to the address listed under section (1a) within 45 days of delivery otherwise it may be subject to a 5% reduction in price.

D. Award of Bid:

1. Award will not be based on price only. Supplier must be qualified to deliver a required number of gallons of winter deicing liquid in the months of November to April. In addition, equipment and response time will be considered.
2. The Newaygo County Road Commission reserves the right to award quantities based on price and service by delivery location in the best interest of the County or to lowest responsible and responsive bidder on lowest average cost.
3. The Newaygo County Road Commission reserves the right to award this contract to more than one bidder, buying in the best interest of the County

E. The right is reserved by the Newaygo County Road Commission for other governmental agencies to piggyback upon award.

F. Cancellation of Contract Provisions:

The Newaygo County Road Commission shall have the right to cancel the Contract for non-performance: Should an inspection by the designated representative reveal the Contractor's work results in any non-acceptable maintenance condition of one or all specified areas:

1. The NCRC's designated representative at the time of the first circumstance shall call for a meeting with the Contractor or issue a written notice of possible Contract termination should the condition continue.
2. If the condition should repeat for a second time, or a second circumstance shall occur, the NCRC's designated representative may issue a written notice of contract termination.
3. If contract is terminated prior to end of contract period, the contractor will not be allowed to rebid on the same contract.

G. Insurance Requirements:

1. Contractor shall save harmless and indemnify the Newaygo County Road Commission, as well as their employees, against all claims for damages to public or private property and for injuries to persons arising out of and during the progress and to the completion of work all in accordance with the 2003 Michigan Department of Transportation's "Standard Specification for Construction", Section 107.10, with the following minimum requirements:

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One Insurance Certificate declaring Newaygo County Road Commission as additional insured, not certificate holder, must be issued and shall become part of contract.

2. Contractor shall maintain current up-to-date insurance coverage during the term of the contract and failure to do so shall result in termination of said contract.
3. Certificate must be submitted within ten days upon notification of award of Contract.

- H. Submission of bid will be construed as a conclusive presumption that the Contractor is thoroughly familiar with the bid requirements and specifications and that he/she understands and agrees to abide by each, and all the stipulations and requirements contained therein.
- I. "The NCRC, in accordance with the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d to 2000d-4 and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Department of Federally-assigned programs of the Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of gender, disability, race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award."

During the performance of this contract, the contractor, for itself, its assignees and successors in interest (hereinafter referred to as the "contractor") agrees as follows:

1. **Compliance with Regulations:** The contractor shall comply with the regulations relative to non-discrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the Department of Transportation, Title 49, code of Federal Regulations, Part 21 as they may be amended from time to time, (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations), which are herein incorporated by reference and made a part of this contract.
2. **Non-discrimination:** The contractor, regarding the work performed by it during the contract shall not discriminate on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in the selection and retention of subcontractors, including procurements of materials and leases of equipment. The contractor shall not participate either directly or indirectly in the discrimination prohibited by section 21.5 of the Regulation, including employment practices when the contractor covers a program set forth in Appendix B of the Regulations.
3. **Solicitations for Subcontracts, Including Procurements of Materials and Equipment:** In all solicitations either by competitive bidding or negotiation made by the contractor for work to be performed under a subcontract, including procurements of materials or leases of equipment, each potential subcontractor or supplier shall be notified by the contractor of the contractor's obligations under this contract and the Regulations relative to non-discrimination on the grounds of race, color, or national origin.
4. **Information and Reports:** The contractor shall provide all information and reports required by the Regulations, or directives issued pursuant thereto, and shall permit access to its books, records, accounts, other sources of information and its facilities as may be determined by the Newaygo County Road Commission to be pertinent to ascertain compliance with such Regulations or directives. Where any information required of a contractor is in the exclusive possession of another who fails or refuses to furnish this information, the contractor shall so certify to the State highway department, or the Federal Highway Administration as appropriate, and shall set forth what efforts it has made to obtain the information.
5. **Sanctions for Non-compliance:** In the event of the contractor's non-compliance with the non-discrimination provisions of this contract, the Newaygo County Road Commission shall impose such contract sanctions as it or the Federal Highway Administration may determine to be appropriate, including, but not limited to:
 - (a) Withholding of payments to the contractor under the contract until the contractor complies, and/or
 - (b) Cancellation, termination or suspension of the contract, in whole or in part.

6. **Incorporation of Provisions:** The contractor shall include the provisions of paragraph (1) through (6) in every subcontract, including procurement of materials and leases of equipment, unless exempt by the Regulations, or directives issued pursuant thereto. The contractor shall take such action with respect to any subcontract or procurement as the Newaygo County Road Commission may direct as a means of enforcing such provisions including sanctions for non-compliance: Provided, however, that, in the event a contractor becomes involved in, or is threatened with, litigation with a subcontractor or supplier as a result of such direction, the contractor may request the Newaygo County Road Commission to enter into such litigation to protect the interest of the County, and, in addition, the contractor may request the State highway department to enter into such litigation to protect the interests of the State and/or the United States to enter into such litigation to protect the interests of the United States.

Technical Specifications

A. Materials:

1. A copy of a current chemical analysis must be included with the bid. Bids submitted without current test results may not be considered.
2. Substitutions or deviations from winter deicing liquid must be authorized prior to delivery by Derek Wawsczyk, Manager, by contacting him at 231-689-6682.
3. Each truck tank load of solution may be sampled by a representative of the Road Commission, either before leaving the loading station or before the solution is unloaded or applied.

B. Analysis of a load may be ordered from a competent chemist in case of a disagreement in total chloride content, and such chemist's conclusions shall be final regarding acceptance of the given load.

C. Copies of the Material Safety Data Sheet for the chlorides must be submitted upon award of bid.
